Dear Sir/Madam,

This is in continuation of the Board's letter of even number dated 9.7.2010 (copy enclosed) wherein you were requested to relieve the officers at the level of Additional/Joint Commissioners, Deputy/Assistant Commissioners for whom transfer orders were issued in AGT-2010 through the Board's Office Order Nos. 92/2010 dated 23.4.2010, 97/2010 dated 5.5.2010 and 113/2010 dated 18.5.2010.

2. Although, it was advised to relieve the officers latest by the 13th July, 2010 and send compliance report to the Board by 15th July, 2010, it is observed from the compliance report received from the DG (HRD) that many officers are yet to be relieved. This is a matter of serious concern to the Board.

3. I may mention that non-relieving of the officers who are under order of transfer in spite of specific direction issued by the Board has been viewed seriously. I would, accordingly, request you to kindly ensure relieving the officers who are yet to be relieved latest by the 02nd August, 2010 without fail.

4. I also request you to send a compliance report accordingly to the Board, latest by the 03rd August 2010, with an endorsement to the DG(HRD) in the format enclosed.
