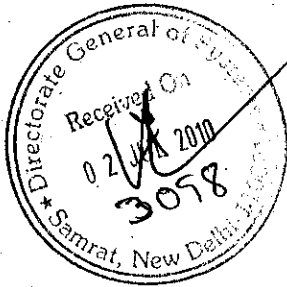

Dear Shri Mitra,

With the increasing importance of economic diplomacy in the overall foreign policy framework of India, there is a requirement to instill a greater degree of economic and financial expertise at the policy-making level within MEA. This requirement is felt particularly in the two specialized economic Divisions of the Ministry of External Affairs, viz the Investment & Technology Promotion Division, and the Multilateral Economic Relations Division.

2. In addition, a number of territorial divisions in MEA are engaged in supervision of bilateral aid projects in countries of diplomatic importance to us. Our commitments in these projects, which are being undertaken not only in neighbouring countries, but also through grant or Credit support in African nations, runs to thousands of crores of rupees. To oversee the implementation of these projects, we require officers with aptitude and experience in monitoring financial transactions, overseeing budgetary impacts, and with a general comfort with financial concepts.

It is felt that officers of the Indian Revenue Service and the Indian Customs & Excise Service would fit well into the above roles. We would be grateful, therefore, if Deputy Secretary/Under Secretary level officers from these two Services could kindly be considered for deputation to MEA. This would not only help MEA acquire specialized knowledge and expertise, but the exposure would also prove useful for the professional development of the officers concerned.

4. I would be grateful if panels of meritorious IRS and IC&ES officers who may be interested in serving in MEA on deputation could kindly be forwarded to us for selection. We would be happy to induct several officers, if available, for a tenure of two or three years.
